Maintenance, Repair, Replacement and Test A17.1-8.6 and Using A17.2

Date: Saturday, April 25th, 2020

1) MRRT A17.1-8.6 The training secession will take the attendee through a brief history of maintenance rules, then the presentation covers the efforts of defining Maintenance, Repair, Replacement and Testing (MRRT) which harmonized in the 2000 code, ultimately detailing the Maintenance Control Program (MCP) requirement as they exist in the 2013 & 2016 Elevator Escalator Safety Code. The Course will cover Definitions, the General MCP requirements, Records and logs, Onsite Documentation, Repair and Replacements, Electric, Hydraulic, Escalator and several other types of elevators which fall under the Scope of A17.1. Each segment will also address the Category one, three and five testing as appropriate and finish with the Special Provisions section located in 8.6.11. The intent of the core is to familiarize the attendees with section 8.6 requirements out in the field.

Standards Used in this presentation: ASME A17.1-2013 & including 2016 updates

2) Using A17.2 : The training course is a interactive and intended to teach the use of and many uses contained within A17.2 Guide for Inspection of Elevators, Escalators and Moving Walks.

It is strongly encouraged that a copy of A17.2 and A17.1 be brought to this class.

The training secession will take the attendee through a brief history, Format and Layout.

Form and arrangement a review of contents to include the mandatory and non-mandatory appendices, links to and from A17.1 specifically category one and five tests and 8.11 periodic inspections and with time permitting five practice scenarios.

The intent of this core course is to familiarize the attendees with A17.2, its function within our inspection industry and it's many uses in the field.

Interested attendees include Inspectors, Mechanics, Supervisors, Managers and anyone else interested in how the ASME A17.2 is to be used and the many tools contained within available to the elevator industry.
