BIO: Edward has 19 years as an elevator mechanic and has been QEI certified since 2008. He is currently a State of Wisconsin Inspector.

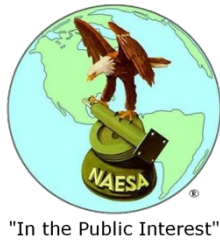


Patrick Bothwell, Draka

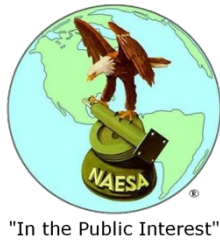

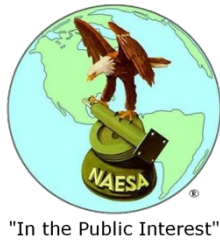

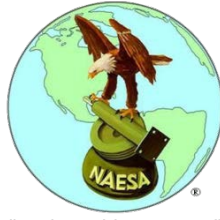
